## Bacon's Rebellion



1675 → Nathaniel Bacon, a planter, raised his own army to fight the Native Americans

Berkeley declared his army illegal


Bacon and his army marched into Jamestown

Bacon told Berkeley of the colonists' grievances, including a lack of representation in the House of Burgesses

The army set fire to Jamestown, and Berkeley fled

When Bacon died a month later, Berkeley returned to retake control

A treaty was signed between the colonists and Native Americans

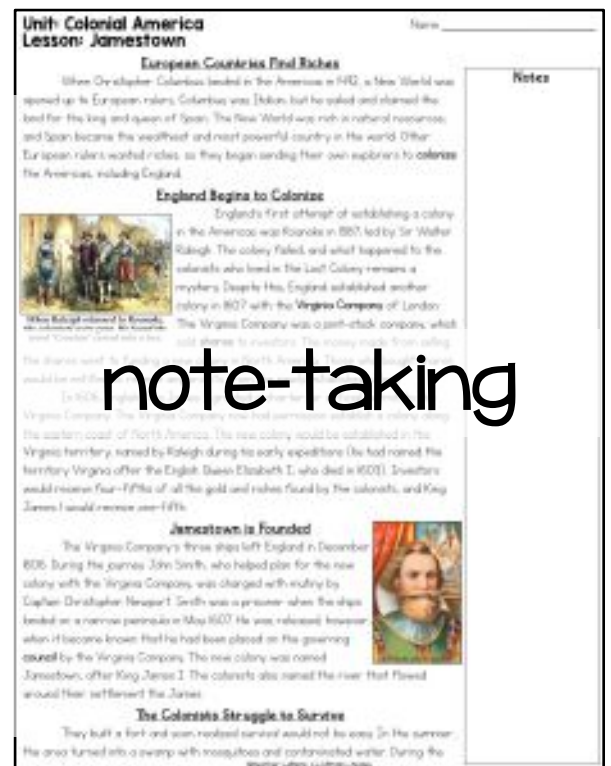

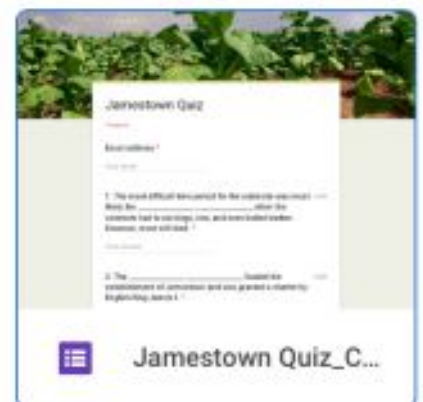

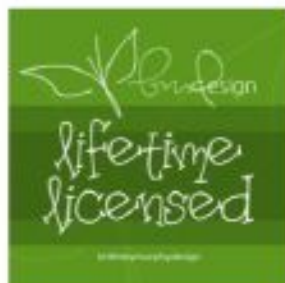
