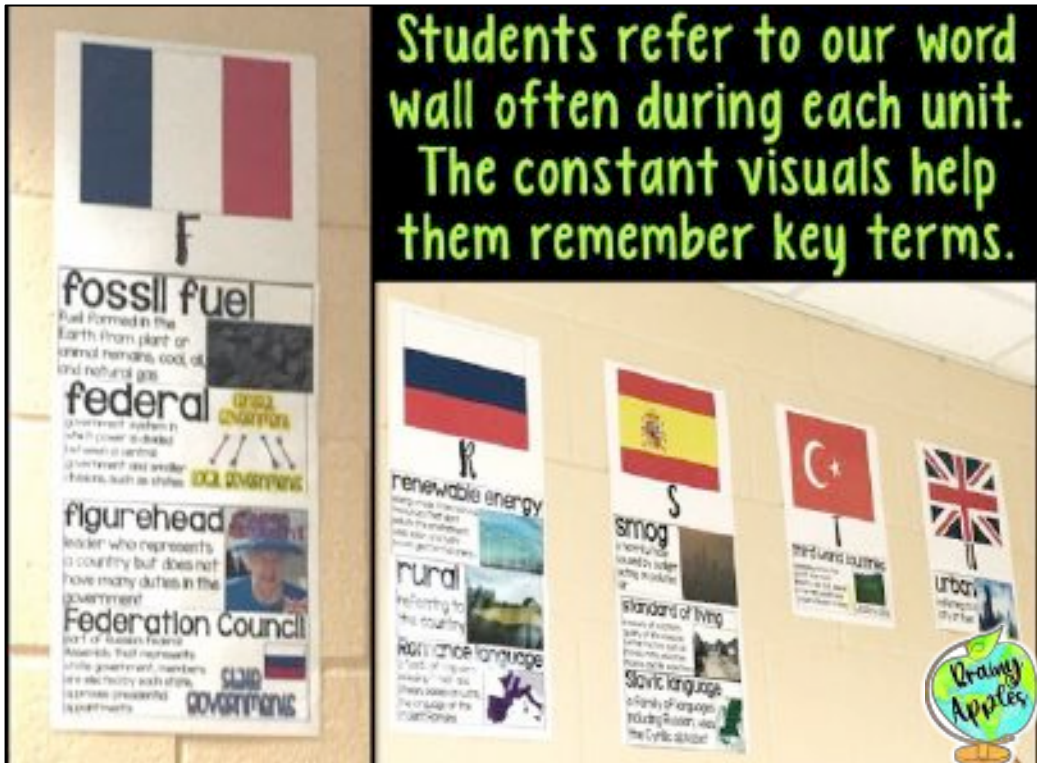

How I use this resource:

All students benefit from having a word wall.



New terms are placed on the board. After the lesson or unit, they go up on our word wall for future reference.



Students refer to our word wall often during each unit. The constant visuals help them remember key terms.

How I use this resource:

- I cut apart the cards, & then laminate them for durability.
- Each word card includes the definition and a visual representation of the word to help students better understand the meaning of the word.
- When first introducing the word, I put the card on my board (or in a pocket chart) and have students complete a variety of vocabulary activities, such as Frayer Models and creating picture dictionaries.
- Then I place the word on our word wall so students can refer to it during the unit.
- I add to the word wall all year. I don't remove cards because I want it to be an active resource my students use that builds over time.
- I don't put words on the wall until after we have completed activities & students understand the word. This ensures students will use the word wall as a resource. If you put all the words up at one time without going over the words with students, it will be overwhelming for them, & they are less likely to use it.
- For students who need extra support, you can print the cards at a reduced size and create personal word walls using key rings. They can keep these rings with them.
- These word cards align to my no prep lessons and curriculum units. These terms are the key terms in the passages.

There are two cards per page to be printer-friendly

mesa

reservoir

a place where water is kept for future use



After I cut them apart, I laminate them for durability. It also makes it easier to remove them from the wall at the end of the year.
